

3 DAYS IN EIDFJORD

FOR THE ACTIVE

Day 1

- Fjordkayak by Best Adventures (3-hours)
- Do the beautiful circular hike, including the trail system and the spectacular step bridge by Vøringsfossen waterfall. Start either at Fossli Hotel or at Fossatromma parking area (1–1.5 hours)

Day 2

- Bike ride to Simadal and Skytjefossen waterfall. The tourist office offers bike rentals (2–3 hours)
- Steep hike to Kjeåsen (1.5–2 hours one way)
- RIB-boat ride by Hardanger Fjordsafari (1 hour)

Day 3

- Visit the Norwegian Nature Centre with a panoramic film and interactive exhibitions (1 hour)
- Walk around Læg Reid (1 hour)



FOR THE CULTURALLY INTERESTED

Day 1

- Walk to the Lake Eidfjordvatnet and around Hæreid with burial mounds from the Viking and Iron Ages (1–1.5 hours)
- Gallery Nils Bergslien, check opening hours
- Walk around Læg Reid, passing the 'knitted trees' along the fjord before heading up to Læg Reid and continuing via Eidfjord Old Church, the new church, and the Viking exhibition (1 hour)
- Drive or hike up to Kjeåsen, check driving times

Day 2

- Photo safari on Hardangervidda and by the fjord with Hardanger Guideservice (2.5–3 hours)
- Viking exhibition at TUNET på Haugen, check opening hours (1 hour)

Day 3

- Visit the Norwegian Nature Centre with a panoramic film and interactive exhibitions (1 hour)
- Visit Vøringsfossen and Fossli Hotel (Edvard Grieg was a regular guest and composed, among other works, Opus 66 here)



FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN

Day 1

- Walk to the Lake Eidfjordvatnet and around Hæreid with burial mounds from the Viking and Iron Ages (1–1.5 hours)
- Go fishing, the fjord is free, no licence needed
- Go to the beach: Kråkeskarvet with a playground for the youngest and a barbecue area or Stavaness sandy beach

Day 2

- Visit the Norwegian Nature Centre with a panoramic film and interactive exhibitions (1 hour)
- Walk along the river in Simadal where there's a shelter and a fire pit for grilling sausages

Day 3

- Viking exhibition at TUNET på Haugen, check opening hours (1 hour)



FOR SENIORS

Day 1

- Walk to the Lake Eidfjordvatnet and around Hæreid with burial mounds from the Viking and Iron Ages (1–1.5 hours)
- Visit the viewing platforms by Fossatromma parking lot or Fossli Hotel with spectacular views of Vøringsfossen waterfall and Måbødalen Valley (0.5 hours)
- Cider tasting at one of the hotels in the town centre, on request

Day 2

- Photo safari on Hardangervidda and by the fjord with Hardanger Guideservice (2.5–3 hours)
- Viking exhibition at TUNET på Haugen, check opening hours (1 hour)
- Gallery Nils Bergslien, check opening hours

Day 3

- Visit the Norwegian Nature Centre with a panoramic film and interactive exhibitions (1 hour)
- Easy walk from Sæbø – Lundarland – Steinberg Bridge – Sæbø in Øvre Eidfjord (1 hour)
