The Hardanger Bridge

THE HARDANGER BRIDGE, which opened on August 17th, 2013, marked a significant development in the region by replacing the ferry connection between Bruravik and Brimnes. This modern bridge has greatly reduced the travel time for those driving from Bergen and Voss to Eidfjord, providing a more direct and efficient route. As Norway's longest suspension bridge, the Hardanger Bridge features two lanes for vehicular traffic, as well as dedicated sidewalks for pedestrians and cyclists, accessible from both sides in Eidfjord and Ulvik. The main span of the bridge measures an impressive 1,310 meters, with a total length of 1,380 meters, surpassing even the iconic Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco in length. This architectural marvel not only enhances the transportation infrastructure of the region but also offers breathtaking views of the surrounding landscapes, making it a popular spot for travelers and photographers. The Hardanger Bridge stands as a symbol of modern engineering and plays a vital role in connecting communities, making travel in this stunning part of Norway faster and more convenient.



Guided Mountain Hike to Halnekollen

Guided Snowshoe Hike/Light Safari (March-April)

- Maximum group size: 20 people
- Snowshoes available for rent at Halne.

Guided Hike (May-October)

- Maximum group size: 40 people
- A short, easy uphill hike, approximately 45 minutes each way. Requires a normal level of physical fitness.

The hike starts at Halne Fjellstugu (1,148 meters above sea level) and follows a trail up to the summit (around 1,350 meters above sea level). Along the way, the view improves steadily, offering breathtaking sights across Hardangervidda National Park. At the top, you'll be rewarded with a stunning 360-degree panorama: Hardangerjøkulen glacier to the west, Hallingskarvet National Park mountain range to the north, and expansive views of Hardangervidda National Park with Gaustatoppen to the southeast. Includes a snack at the summit.



RIB Boat Transport on Halnefjorden

Experience a scenic RIB boat journey across lake Halnefjorden in the heart of Hardangervidda. The boat departs from Halne Fjellstugu, located along highway RV7, and travels to Skaupa and Sleipa at the far end of the fjord. The crossing takes about 20 minutes and brings you roughly 13 kilometers into the mountain plateau. Taking the boat opens up a range of possibilities — hike back to Halne, enjoy fishing in the area, or continue your adventure deeper into Hardangervidda National Park. Regular departures are available in July and parts of August. Outside these periods, transport can be arranged upon request. For schedules, ticket booking, or arranging transport outside regular times, visit halne.no



Hardangervidda National Park

Hardangervidda National Park is Norway's largest national park, offering endless opportunities for outdoor adventures. In summer, explore well-marked trails for walking and hiking, while winter brings excellent cross-country skiing routes. Choose between cabin-to-cabin treks or day trips while staying at one of the many accommodations along Route 7 or in Eidfjord. Popular gateways to the park include Hjølmadalen in Øvre Eidfjord, Tinnhølvegen near Dyranut, and various points along Route 7 across Hardangervidda. A toll road to Tinnhøl, open from July 1st, provides an 11 km scenic drive on a gravel road into the park. However, summer bridges are typically installed by early July, and high river levels can make crossings challenging before then. For a unique approach, take the boat across Halnefjorden and begin your hike from the Eidfjord region. For more hiking suggestions, visit visiteidfjord.no and check out "Hiking in Hardangervidda."







During winter 2025 we offer private guided snowshoe hikes for families and small groups of up to 7 people on the Hardangervidda Plateau, the largest and highest plateau in Northern Europe. Join us for a family-friendly photo safari, perfect for those with younger children. Experience the breathtaking sunset during an easy evening snowshoe hike. Is your child eager to spot some grouse? Don't worry – we provide binoculars for anyone interested in wildlife or for getting a closer look at *Hardangerjøkulen*, the sixth-largest glacier in mainland Norway. If you're looking for peace and solitude, join us on a serene snowshoe walk through Norway's largest national park. We'll use only torches or headlamps as light sources, letting you fully immerse in the quiet beauty of this vast landscape.

Sysendammen

Sysendammen is one of Norway's largest stone-filled dams, stretching 1,160 meters in length and built with 3.6 million cubic meters of stone and moraine material. From the parking lot, visitors can enjoy stunning views of the *Hardangerjøkulen* glacier.

Vøringsfossen Waterfall

From the stunning viewing platforms near the Fossli Hotel to the step bridge crossing the river and the newly built paths leading to Fossatromma, Vøringsfossen offers an unforgettable experience. Watch vast amounts of water plunge 182 meters from the Hardangervidda plateau into the dramatic Måbødal valley. Vøringsfossen is Norway's most iconic waterfall. Construction on the upgraded viewing platforms and walking paths began in 2015 as part of the National Scenic Routes initiative. The project, including a parking area with toilets and charging stations at Fossatromma, was completed in September 2024. For those seeking adventure, a path through the canyon offers a breathtaking hike through the wild, untamed landscape surrounding the waterfall. Parking and toilet facilities at Fossli and Fossatromma are open from April 1 to October 31, depending on snow levels. Heavy snow, ice, or adverse weather conditions may delay opening or require early closure.

The Norwegian Nature Center is located on the most popular traveled route between Bergen and Oslo. The center is located in Øvre Eidfjord along the national tourist road Rv 7, near the Hardangerfjord and Vøringsfossen waterfall at the foot of the Hardangervidda mountain plateau.

At the Norwegian Nature Center you can experience:

- The panorama film "Norge mitt land – Fjord, mountain, waterfall and Hardangervidda"
- Feel the dramatic forces that have shaped our mountains, fjords and glaciers
- Explore the weather, climate and discover Hardangervidda's rich animal and plant life
- Meet reindeer, elk and deer and see the mountain aureus in our aquariums
- See how humans have lived and supported themselves, and used the resources from nature
- Experience the interaction between Norwegian art and nature in our art and nature theatre
- Taste Norwegian cuisine with rich traditions and local ingredients in our restaurant Hardangerviddahallen

Kjeåsen Viewpoint

Kjeåsen is often described as the world's most isolated settlement, perched like an eagle's nest 530 meters above the Simadalsfjord. The settlement gained access to a road in 1974, which was built as part of the power development project. The road begins in Simadal, about 8 km from Eidfjord / Route7. The 5 km journey to the viewpoint includes 2.5 km of winding road, followed by a narrow tunnel. Due to the road's limited width, traffic regulations are in place: vehicles can drive up to Kjeåsen every full hour, and down every half hour. You can either drive or take the spectacular hike up the mountainside to experience the breathtaking view.

Immerse yourself in the Viking era using all your senses. Explore our exhibition of historical replicas and photos of ancient finds. Listen to music played on Viking-age instruments, experience the scents of herbs used in their meals, and feel the fabrics they crafted. A fascinating documentary brings local Viking history to life, adding depth to your visit. Learn about the Hæreid Viking Burial Grounds—the largest Viking and Iron Age site in Western Norway. Join Ravenheart Hardanger on this journey through time and discover why Eidfjord was once a powerful Iron Age center!

Fjordcruise on Hardangerkongen

Normally, the trip begins by sailing into the Simadal Fjord and turning around in front of the power station. The journey continues along the western side of the Simadal Fjord and eventually along the Eidfjord. Along the way, we pass waterfalls, abandoned settlements, and areas that occasionally offer glimpses of wildlife.

The mountain farms Kjeåsen and Skår will be visible from the boat, and with a high cloud ceiling, you can also catch sight of the Hardanger Glacier (Hardangerjøkulen).

It's a two-hour round trip at a speed of 10 knots, focusing on the fjord landscape and the birds and animals found along the way. The captain knows the area well and can share stories and facts about what you see during the trip. The boat can also be chartered for other trips, with a maximum capacity of 12 passengers.

Hike to Hæreid

Embark on a 6 km long scenic hike starting from the center of Eidfjord, following the picturesque Eio River as it leads you to the beautiful sandy beach at Lake Eidfjordvatnet. This peaceful route takes you through serene landscapes, offering both natural beauty and a glimpse into the area's rich history. At the top of Hæreid, you'll discover the largest gravesite from the Iron Age and Viking Age in Western Norway, with nearly 400 burial mounds dating from 400-1000 AD. These ancient graves are located on the Hæreid Plateau, which is approximately a 30-minute walk from the center of Eidfjord. Along the way, you'll pass Hodna, where you can enjoy a spectacular view of the charming Eidfjord below, offering a perfect spot for photos and reflection. This hike is a wonderful blend of nature, history, and panoramic vistas, making it a truly memorable experience.

Ostangen Park is a perfect blend of relaxation, recreation, and stunning views, making it a must-visit spot for those exploring Eidfjord.

Safety Guidelines and Route Suggestion



Route Suggestion

Simadal valley and Skjervefossen waterfall

This is by far the nicest and safest route for bike rides in Eidfjord, away from the heavily trafficked Road 7. Follow the fjord from Eidfjord to Simadal. Along the way you will pass by a couple of nice beaches by the fjord, a perfect place for a dip to cool down on warm days. Ride past the intersection for the road to Kjeåsen (it's not possible to bike up to Kjeåsen), and follow the asphalt road as far as you can go in to the valley. You will reach a gravel road that you can ride to the end and you'll see the Skjervefossen waterfall (one of the highest in Norway with 300 meters free fall) up in the right hand mountain side.

Starting point: The centre of Eidfjord.

Distance: 11,5 km (one way).

Total ascent: 255 m.

Total biking time: 2-3 hrs (round trip).





THE YELLOW ROUTE on the map takes you to the graves from the Iron- and Viking ages (7) on the Hæreid mountain plateau appr. 100 metres above sea level. This is the largest prehistoric burial ground in Western Norway. During your roundtrip you'll get to a very nice viewpoint of the fjord from Hodna (8). Starting point: By the bridge. Duration: 75-90 minutes.

THE DARK BLUE ROUTE on this map takes you to the churches (4 + 5) in Eid fjord, the new church from 1980 and the old, mideaval St. Jacobs church built in 1309 (closed). Visit Tråagarden Farm (3). Experience local farm traditions and livestock. Farm shop with local cider and apple juice from Draopar. Visit Ravenheart Viking Exhibit (9) on your way back. These are both open on most days with cruise ships. Duration: appr. 60 min.

THE LIGHT BLUE ROUTE continue your trek from the yellow route. The route goes from Hereidsvegen on to a rough path with great fjord views, thereafter steep down to a residential area and further on along the fjord back to the center. This route is a bit more difficult than the other routes. Duration: appr. 60 min.

Olav H. Hauge-exhibition

The centre is located by the fjord in the village centre of Ulvik. The exhibition presents the life and work of Olav H. Hauge (1908-1994), one of Norway's most important modern poets. He is especially known for short, clear poems inspired by nature, everyday life and classical literature.

Hauge's poetry has had a strong influence on Norwegian literature and is widely read both nationally and internationally. His work has been translated into more than 25 languages.

The exhibition also includes poetry by other world poets, interactive elements suitable for children, and the "cat hunt" activity. Olav H. Hauge's personal book collection is on display at the centre and is open to the public.

The centre has a shop with books and gifts in several languages. During the summer season, daily guided tours are available. Private guided tours for groups can be booked in advance.
